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Dr. Vishnu Priye Director IIIT, Ranchi

ne **Director** of *Indian Institute of Information* was established in year 2016 as an 'Institute of e act of Parliament' is a dynamic personality with ademics and administration. Since July 20, 2018, a Institute of Technology (ISM) Dhanbad where he is lectronics Engineering.

7 30, 2018, he was Dean (Research & Development) the administration. During his period the resource reached about Rs 24 crores. There were more than ding (MoUs) signed by him on behalf of the Institute ational Universities and Industries. He was deeply

involved with other core members and Director, IIT(ISM) Dhanbad, in bringing out major changes that resulted in conversion of Indian School of Mines Dhanbad into Indian Institute of Technology on September 6, 2017. He became the first Dean (R & D) of IIT(ISM) Dhanbad. For a brief period, he was in additional charge of Dean (Faculty & Planning).

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Dr. Vishnu Priye was Head, Department of Electronics Engineering, IIT(ISM) Dhanbad from August 13, 2012 to December 31, 2014 where his main focus was to interact with core industries in electronics. Due to the interactions, companies like National Instruments and Texas instruments interacted with students and gave pre-placement offers to couple of them. He played a major role in obtaining 'Fund for Improvement of S & T Infrastructure (FIST)' project of Rs 1.10 crores from Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India. He was also instrumental as Head of the Department in establishment of Centre of Renewable Energy. He was the General Chair of 'International Conference on Microwave & Photonics ICMAP' organized in years 2013 and 2015.

With a prolific teaching experience, he has mentored 17 research scholars as supervisor culminating into the award of Ph.D. degree and 3 scholars are presently registered for Ph.D under him. He has over hundred publications of which over 35 are in SCI/SCIE indexed international journals.

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Dr. Vishnu Priye received 'Best Researcher Award of ISM' for Year 2014 from then Honorable Minister of HRD – Madam Smriti Zubin Irani. As Principal Investigator (PI), he has procured and completed R & D Projects of over Rs 1 crore sponsored by Ministry of Information Communication Technology and Ministry of HRD, in areas of Erbium Doped Fiber (EDF) Amplifiers and EDF Multiwavelength Tunable Source. Currently, he is PI of Department of Science & Technology (DST) project on 'Optical Weighbridge'. Apart from R & D Projects, he was Consultant in Charge (CI) of Professional Development Programs (PDP) for participants from Industry and Academia generating a revenue of over Rs 8 lakhs.

In Phase 1 of Technical Education Quality Improvement Program (TEQIP – 1) of Government of India, he was selected as 'Performance Auditor/Mentor' by State Project Facilitation Unit (SPFU) and National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU). He contributed constructively for institutes like BIT Sindri, Ranchi Polytechnic and Dumka Polytechnic under SPFU and NIT Jamshedpur under NPIU. He is a Senior Member, IEEE, Member, OSA, Member, SPIE and Fellow OSI and Indian Institution of Engineers. Also, he is a Faculty Advisor, Students' Chapters of OSA and SPIE.

He completed his Ph.D (Year 1990) in Fiber Optics from Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi and D.Engg.(Year 1996) in Electronics & Information Science from Kyoto Institute of Technology, Kyoto, Japan. He has been Visiting Professor at Kyoto Institute of Technology, Kyoto, Japan (June 1 to August 31, 2000), University of Colorado, Boulder, USA (June 1 to August 31, 2013), City University, London, UK (June 15 to July 15, 2015), and Aarhus University, Herning, Denmark (June 1 to July 15, 2018).

Dr. Vishnu Priye's dedication and commitment towards his work is unparalleled.

It's a proud moment for the Editorial team of SPECTATOR that we got an opportunity to interact with him for this section.

Let's Start

Mr. Amit: What inclined you to adopt this career?

Dr Vishnu Priye: Two things basically – Firstly, independence in your work and secondly you are exposed to new areas of knowledge in their nascent stage. For example, I worked on Fiber optic communication which was known to very few but now a kid knows about fiber connectivity and data rate it supports. Directorship and administration were part of journey but never a destination

Mr. Amit: Because this a very responsible task, how do you manage?

Dr Vishnu Priye: Teaching & Research job is a passion so they are auto managed. Directorship is managed due to experiences I had during my tenure as HoD and Dean at IIT (ISM) Dhanbad. Common sense and doing proper homework also helps in taking quick and correct decisions.

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Mr. Amit: What is the biggest challenge at your job? How do you approach them?

Dr Vishnu Priye: As the founder Director of IIIT Ranchi is to get job done by young faculty and staff. Most of the time I have to spell out clear cut instructions, provide ample freedom to execute and with reasonable time line.

Mr. Amit: According to you what is the key to developing a good team?

Dr Vishnu Priye: The key is to understand the strength and weakness of the team members and assign challenges accordingly. Every player should cover other players back and should understand that team is greater than the individual.

Mr. Amit: Give me an example of when you thought outside of the box. How did it help your Faculty?

Dr Vishnu Priye: Establishing Research Cells were one that brought the best in the faculty in terms of research and academic output. Identifying motto 3 D for the institute so that IIIT Ranchi can orient it's effort in <u>Data Science</u>, <u>Digital Technology and Design Thinking</u>. In coming 10 years IIIT Ranchi will be the hub in East India in these 3 areas.

Mr. Amit: How do you manage your personal and professional life?

Dr Vishnu Priye: By keeping it simple and not mixing the two. I take care of my professional life and my spouse takes care of my personal life.

Mr. Amit: What can you tell us about your experience about the IIIT?

Dr Vishnu Priye: Overall fabulous. Interacting with young recruits, deciding and implementing 5 years roadmap, and seeing an institute of national importance to take shape from scratch was really thrilling. Placement package of Rs 83.38 lakhs and Hon'ble President of India, Governor of Jharkhand and CM of Jharkhand gracing the 2nd Convocation has given fillip to credentials of IIIT Ranchi and individual pride to me and my team mates.

Mr. Amit: 65 acres of land has been given in Sanga village of Kanke for the new permanent campus of IIIT. Tell us something about that?

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Dr Vishnu Priye: In 65 acres 52 acres was the major chunk of land and the remaining chunk was about 3 kms away with no access. In Phase I, focus is on developing the major portion of land. Boundary wall is complete and construction work has started by CPWD.

Mr. Amit: Last year Computer Science student Ekta Kumari got an annual package of 46 lakh rupees from Amazon company, what is the highest expectation of package in placement this year?

Dr Vishnu Priye: This year 12 students are selected in Amazon with a package of ~ 45 lakhs. Another student broke all records by getting placed in Atlassian for a package of Rs 83.38 lakhs. Placement scenario is very promising with few students bagging more than one job.

Mr. Amit: What skills are required in your position on a day-to-day basis? **Dr Vishnu Priye**:

- Making a practical and executable goals for the day
- > Positive mental state
- Ouick decisions
- > Time management

These four have worked for me till date.

Mr. Amit: How do you evaluate success?

Dr Vishnu Priye: A very relative term. If for a person,

[Achievement ≥ (Talent + hard work + circumstances)], he can be termed successful.

Mr. Amit: Lack of teachers and promotion is the main problem of the education sector; how will it be solved?

Dr Vishnu Priye: More than lack of teachers, there is a lack of passionate teachers and apathy of employers in the private sector. Education Sector is booming now. University Authority should give salaries equivalent to government college and provide research facilities for their growth. If faculty grows, institute grows as it attracts more students and is also able to make a niche in NIRF ranking. Promotion policy should be made on performance in Academics, Research and Administrative contributions.

The solution is understanding that teachers are backbone of the organization and administration is there to support them perform to the best of their capabilities. For me, status of faculty is much more than that of a Director as we are just facilitators.

Mr. Amit: How have you met your life partner? How did you know that she is right for you?

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Dr Vishnu Priye: I met my life partner on the day of engagement. I trusted God and played the gamble. As the years unfolded, the gamble proved to be right. She has been a pillar of strength for me and we have thoroughly enjoyed the ups and downs of life - journey spanning 36 years.

Mr. Amit: A faculty member approaches you with a serious problem. How do you proceed and solve it?

Dr Vishnu Priye: I am a good researcher and very good at problem solving. Problems are solved in 3 steps – listening carefully to the problem, judging the seriousness of the problem and executing measures to mitigate and solve the problem.

Mr. Amit: How did you come to know about YBN University? Have you ever visited YBNU?

Dr Vishnu Priye: I do not know how YBNU came to know about me. I came to know YBNU through young and talented Er. Vinita of YBNU. Yes, I have visited once and given a talk also on behest and persuasion of Er. Vinita.

Mr. Amit: Please give a message to students of YBN University?

Dr Vishnu Priye: My message is loud and clear. Use these years of University to acquire and develop multi-skills. Skills, hard work and good behavior help you climb the ladder of success like nothing else can do.






YBN University administered State DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY EXAMINATION

Their question papers were distributed late due to some reasons, as such they were given extra 20 min. The other students, however, failed to understand it."






<u>INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY, NSS</u>




Tobacco Free Environment, NSS



सावन का महीना हिन्दू धार्मिक कैलेण्डर का 5वां महीना और हिन्दू आस्था से जुड़ा एक पवित्र महीना होता है। सावन के महीने को हिन्दू धार्मिको में बेहद खास माना जाता है। इस माह में भगवान शिव की पूजा की जाती है। पौराणिक मान्यता के अनुसार,पार्वती जी ने शिव जी को प्रसन्न करने के लिए कई वर्षों तक कठोर तप किया था। वो श्रावण का महीना ही था, जब शिव जी ने प्रसन्न होकर उन्हें दर्शन दिए और उन्हें पत्नी के तौर पर स्वीकार किया। इसके बाद दोनों का विवाह महाशिवरात्रि पर कराया गया। माता पार्वती से मिलन के कारण ये माह शिव जी को बेहद प्रिय है। मान्यता है कि इस माह में जो भी भक्त उनकी पूरी श्रद्धा और भक्ति से पूजा अर्चना करता है, महादेव उसकी कामना को जरूर पूरा करते हैं। यही वजह है कि सावन आते ही मंदिरों में भक्तों की कतार लग जाती है।

झारखंड के देवघर में एक प्रसिद्ध मंदिर है। शिव का एक नाम 'वैद्यनाथ भी है, इस कारण लोग इसे 'वैद्यनाथ धाम' भी कहते हैं। यह एक सिद्धपीठ है। इस कारण इस लिंग को "कामना लिंग" भी कहा जाता हैं। इसके अलावा अंगराबारी-शिव मंदिर प्रसिद्ध धार्मिक केंद्र है जो अपने शिव मंदिर के लिए जाना जाता है। हर साल सावन में स्थानीय एवं दूर दर्ज से लोग यहाँ जल चढाने आतें है। यह जिला मुख्यालय से 9 किमी दूर खूँटी-तोरपा रोड पर स्थित है। झारखंड की राजधानी रांची में आस्था का बड़ा केंद्र पहाड़ी मंदिर है। इस पहाड़ी पर भगवान का शिव मंदिर है। यहां भी काफी संख्या में भीड़ उमड़ती है। राजधानी रांची के नामकोम में स्थित है मराशिलि पहाड़ मंदिर रातों-रात अपने आप बना है। इस मंदिर में 4 दरवाजे हैं। कोई नहीं जानता इस मंदिर को किसने और कब बनवाया है। यहां का शिवलिंग स्वमभू है, जिस वजह से इसकी काफी मान्यताएं हैं। और रांची के च्टिया स्थित स्रेश्वरधाम में शिवलिंग देश के दूसरे सबसे बड़े शिवलिंग है। मंदिर को बनाने में 10 साल का समय लगा है। शंखनाद होने पर मंदिर के अंदर शंख की आवाज करीब एक मिनट तक गूंजती है। इस शिव लिंग पर एक साथ 50 लोग जल अर्पण कर सकते है। गौरतलब है कि ये शिवलिंग कर्नाटक स्थित कौटिल्य लिंगेश्वर मंदिर जितना ऊंचा है। इस सब स्थलों पर रांची के कौने-कौने से जैसे धुर्वा, हटिया, बूटी मोर वहीं अन्य जिले जैसे

गुड्डा, चाईबासा, धनबाद, बोकारो, जमशेदपुर, सरायकेला खरसावां से भी लोग यहां जल चढाने आतें है।

सावन का महीने में हरे रंग का खास महत्व है। हरे रंग को प्रकृति का रंग माना गया है। सावन महीना के शुरू होते ही चारों तरफ हरियाली ही हरियाली नजर आने लगती है। झमाझम बारिश से मौसम भी सुहाना हो जाता है। सावन महीने में सुहागिनों का खास पर्व हरियाली तीज भी होता है। वर्षाऋतु में रक्षा बंधन भी होता हैं। सावन के पवित्र महीने में महिलायें मेहंदी लगाती, झूला झूलती और श्रृंगार कर हरी-हरी चूड़ियां पहनती हैं। भोलेनाथ और प्रकृति के बीच गहरा संबंध माना गया है। भोलेबाबा का वास भी प्रकृति की गोद हिमालय में है। इस वजह से सावन में हरे रंग का खास महत्व है।

इस माह में शिवलिंग पर जल जरूर अर्पित करना चाहिए। इस महीने फल, फूल और बेलपत्र शिवलिंग पर चढ़ाने से भगवान भोलेनाथ प्रसन्न होते हैं। अगर कुछ भी ना हो तो केवल मात्र एक लोटा जल चढ़ा देने से ही भगवान भोलेनाथ प्रसन्न हो जाते हैं। जल चढ़ाने से पहले पंचामृत चढ़ाना भी अच्छा माना जाता है। इस माह में दूध का दान करने से भी भगवान भोलेनाथ प्रसन्न होते हैं। इस माह में गाय और बैल की सेवा करना भी उत्तम माना गया है। सावन के महीने में सावन का व्रत रखने से भी भोलेनाथ को प्रसन्न होते हैं। भगवान भोलेनाथ के साथ माता पार्वती की भी पूजा करनी चाहिए। इस माह में गरीबों की सेवा भी करनी चाहिए उन्हें भोजन कपड़े आदि दान करने से भी भगवान भोलेनाथ प्रसन्न होते हैं।

कुछ बात जो सावन के महीने में नहीं करना चाहिए जैसे दिन के समय नहीं सोना चाहिए। शिवलिंग पर केतकी का फूल भी नहीं चढ़ाना चाहिए। सावन के महीने में भूलकर भी मांस, मदिरा का सेवन नहीं करना चाहिए। सावन के महीने में लहसुन, प्याज और बैंगन खाने से भी बचना चाहिए। सावन के पवित्र माह में शिवलिंग पर दूध अर्पित किया जाता है। ऐसे में इस महीने कच्चे दूध का सेवन करने से बचना चाहिए। By:-

How Can the First Year of a Student be amazing?

The initial few weeks of undergraduate education should be a student's springboard into an academic career. But some students vanish even before colleges know that they are there. Student retention has long been a focus of educational research and campus interventions, but few people have examined the earliest stages of a student's academic life which is changing. A large number of researchers are scrutinizing students' early experiences on campus and devising interventions to simplify curricula requirements, increase the sense of belonging, and provide intensive advising during the first year. With the help from different organizations, those colleges are developing new ways to support students at risk of stopping out or leaving early without a degree. Many break off students are minoritized and the first in their family to go to college.

Several organizations that are working closely with colleges to improve educational interventions early in students' academic lives. The key question is "how do we onboard, support, and transit students into, through and then out of the first year, and revamp it in a manner so all the students can succeed here?" According to an expert, the family income, and dream job determine which students will succeed in higher education. It has been noticed that colleges have increased transparency on areas where composite course requirements prevent students from advancing into the substantive courses of a major. It also offers colleges more insight into opportunities to implement early interventions and to improve the educational success of its students. Colleges have often assumed that the students who failed few subjects or courses were simply not smart or hardworking enough to pass them.

Many students coming from poorly resourced high schools were often declared not "smart enough" and assigned to do remedial lessons. One new approach is to give students instruction in development material. I think orientations and other onboarding workshops for students should also be mandatory, not to be draconian but because otherwise the students most at risk will not attend.

Embedded peer support can make an improvement in first- and second-year retention rates.

The schools and colleges have to work on "Caring Campus," which seeks behavioural commitments from faculty and staff members to show students they are part of a caring community. The behavioural commitments are disarmingly simple and all based on research into the practices of teachers who have a track record of keeping their students in schools or colleges. One commitment, for example, is to learn students' preferred names and use them. Another key suggestions, such as creating "moments that matter" by having instructors engage students one on-one to learn about their lives.

Teachers should also consider changing the name of "office hours" to "student hours," so students realize they are not interrupting the teacher's work but are the central reason the teacher is there. One of the Caring Campus principles is situational fairness which encourages teachers to treat the students individually when they are not able to turn in assignments on time. However, I do object to the idea that colleges are the main places where students should be taught the importance of deadlines. What I've noticed is that it's not so much that they need help understanding what deadlines are. They need someone to understand that they sometimes have multiple deadlines, all at the same time, and there's only so much time in their day.


For student success, rather than emphasizing bureaucratic rigidity, colleges should focus on academic rigor. Outside of faculty, staff members are unsung heroes and they need to be better utilized in student-success efforts. Staff members are often the first people students come into contact with as they find their way on campus. When they can't help a student, for instance, they are committed to doing a "warm hand-off," by calling ahead to another department or walking a student over. "We never want to leave a student feeling that they didn't get the help they needed. Therefore, we have to prepare our institution to be ready for our students instead of making our students be ready for us.

I would say that redesigning higher-education institutions to make students feel a greater sense of belonging from their first encounters, and provide them with more sustained levels of support to complete their education is the top priority.
